


PATHWAY TO PARTNERSHIP STEP ONE



Origin Story

In 1999 David and LaRae Pepper clearly sensed that God was leading them to a specific mission. David, who was born and raised on the mission fields of Peru, had developed a strong desire to bring a life-giving church to the Meadow Lakes area and the Matanuska-Susitna Valley in Alaska.

The humble beginnings of Church on the Rock started in the home of Dave and Rebecca Dargis, but quickly grew to take up first one, then two spaces at a local strip mall, growing from one service to three. Wasilla Campus was built and opened Easter of 2005 where it was evident that even in the larger facility, two services would still be needed. During this time of growth, we sent out staff to plant a new church in Battleground, Washington.

As the church continued to grow, a second campus was launched in Palmer at Sherrod Elementary School with Pastor Chris and Laurie Miller. Pastor Jonathan and Kitri Walker also headed out to plant a COTR in Homer, Alaska. After five years of partnering with Aaron Weisser to establish COTR Homer, Pastor Jonathan and Kitri were invited to return in 2013, to take the helm as Lead Pastor of COTR here in the Mat-Su Valley.

Church on the Rock has continued to expand its borders, as one church community in multiple locations, now in Palmer, Wasilla, Willow, and Talkeetna/Sunshine. Our Administrative Programs, Thrifter's Rock Palmer and Wasilla, and Band of Brothers, serve the mission beyond the walls of the church to impact our community.

Leadership Model

As you consider investing your energy, time, and finances to partner with our COTR family, we know that it is important for you to feel confident and comfortable with our particular leadership model. Our goal in describing COTR's leadership structure is so you can better understand how our church intentionally contends for an environment that values integrity, accountability, and spiritual authority.

Shepherding Elders and Board of Directors

Shepherding Elders - Seek God's direction for the mission of COTR and provide Godly counsel in the pursuit of accomplishing that mission. They also provide shepherding care for the local campus they represent. Lastly, they provide to the Board of Directors an annual assessment of the Lead Pastor's spiritual health and leadership effectiveness.

Board of Directors - Ensures that COTR functions in an ethical manner at a responsible cost as we seek to fulfill our purpose. They do so by providing the framework for how we function through written policies and routine assessments.

Central Leadership

This core team is responsible for managing the operations of COTR in the accomplishment of our vision and purpose. This team is typically comprised of three roles:

- Lead Pastor
- Director/Pastor of Ministries
- Director/Pastor of Operations

Campus Pastors

They provide oversight and leadership at their local campus within the established vision, purpose, and structure of COTR. They are the first line of shepherding and managerial authority for their local staff and congregation.

Central Services

This team supports all COTR campuses as well as our Administrated Programs by providing:

- · Budgeting and accounting services and oversight
- · Data management, systems, and communications
- Local and global missions outreach and direction
- Graphic design, website management, and social media support

Statement of Faith

Simply speaking...

- God is more powerful, more loving, and much closer than we can imagine.

We believe in the present and active work of God the Holy Spirit in both the regeneration of the soul and the operation of the gifts. We believe in the accuracy and infallibility of the written Scriptures in regards to life, godliness, and the knowledge of God. We believe in the bodily resurrection from the dead as well as the eternal-state existence for all humanity (past and present), some to eternal life and others to eternal destruction.

Complete Doctrinal Statement

ABOUT GOD

God is the creator and ruler of the universe and all created things. He has eternally existed in three persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. These three are distinct in personage yet co-equal in power, authority, and eternal existence and yet are one God. (Genesis 1:1,26, 27; 3:22; Psalm 90:2; Matthew 28:19; 1 Peter 1:2; 2 Corinthians 13:14)

ABOUT THE FATHER

The distinct role of God the Father is eternal, transcendent, and spirit. His distinct characteristics are visible in the New Testament description of His relationship to God the Son. While co-equal in their eternal relationship, Jesus in His earthly ministry and humanity lived in perfect submission to the will of the Father. The role of God the Father is described in some of the following ways; eternal, giver of every good and perfect gift, chastening those He loves, compassionate and tender. (James 1:17, Psalm 103 3:13, Hebrews 12:6)

ABOUT JESUS CHRIST

Jesus Christ is eternally begotten of God the Father, born of a virgin, and is equal with the Father and the Holy Spirit. Jesus lived a sinless human life and offered Himself as the perfect sacrifice for the sins of all humanity by dying on a cross. He rose from the dead after three days to demonstrate His power over sin and death. He ascended to Heaven's glory and will return again to earth to reign as King of Kings and Lord of Lords. (Matthew 1:22, 23; Isaiah 9:6; John 1:1-5; 14:10-30; Hebrews 4:14, 15; 1 Corinthians 15:3, 4; Romans 1:3,4; Acts 1:9-11; 1 Timothy 6:14, 15; Titus 2:13)

ABOUT THE HOLY SPIRIT

The Holy Spirit is equal with the Father and the Son as God. He is present in the world to make humanity aware of their need for Jesus Christ. He also resides in every christian from the moment of salvation. He provides the christian with power for living, understanding of spiritual truth, and guidance in doing what is right. The christian seeks to live under the Holy Spirit's control daily. (2 Cor 3:17; John 14:16-17; 16:7-13; Acts 1:8; 1 Cor. 2:12; 3:16; Eph 1:13; Gal 5:25)

ABOUT MANKIND

Mankind is made in the spiritual image of God, to be like Him in character. We are the supreme object of God's creation. Although humanity has tremendous potential for good, we are marred by an attitude of disobedience toward God called sinful desire. Sin separates humanity from God. (Genesis 1:27; Psalm 8:3-6; Isaiah 53:6a; Romans 3:23; Isaiah 59:1, 2)

ABOUT ETERNITY

Humanity was created to exist forever. We will either exist eternally separated from God by sin or in union with God through salvation. To be eternally separated from God is to be in hell. To be

eternally in union with Him is eternal life in Heaven. Heaven and hell are real places of eternal existence. (John 3:16; John 2:25; 1 John 5:11-13; Romans 6:23; Revelation 20:11-15)

ABOUT SALVATION

Salvation is a gift from God to humanity. We can never make up for our sin by self-improvement or good works. Only by trusting in Jesus Christ as God's offer of forgiveness can we be saved from sin's penalty. Eternal life begins the moment one receives Jesus Christ into their life by faith. (Romans 6:23; Ephesians 2:8, 9; John 1:12; 14:6; Titus 3:5; Galatians 3:26; Romans 5:1)

ABOUT BAPTISM

Water: the believer publicly confesses their faith in Jesus Christ by obedience through water baptism. - Matthew 3:11; Luke 3:16; John 1:26; Matthew 28:20)

Holy Spirit: the "baptism" in the Holy Spirit, according to Acts 2:4, is available to all who ask for it.

ABOUT THE BIBLE

The Bible is God's Word to all humanity, written by human authors under the supernatural guidance of the Holy Spirit. It is the supreme source of our understanding of God, truth for life, purpose, and eternity. Inspired by God, the Bible is truth without any mixture of error in its intention or message. (2 Tim 1:13; 3:16; 2 Peter 1:20, 21; Psalm 12:6; Psalm 119:105,160; Prov 30:5)

ABOUT THE CHURCH

The Bible tells us that the Church is the "body of Christ" in the world today. The New Testament tells us that the local church is comprised of baptized Christ followers who gather together. The head of the Church is Jesus Christ. The biblical purposes of the Church are worship, evangelism, fellowship, discipleship, and care for others. Support of the ministry and local church is to be accomplished through tithing and the giving of offerings. God's design is that these funds be brought into the local church for the work of the ministry and for distribution to places of need.

Statement on Human Sexuality

We believe the Christian Bible is the foundational source for all moral and ethical issues and we form our understanding based on its authority.

While we believe that these things are made obvious in the Scriptures, we also refuse to withhold love and compassion from those who would disagree.

We believe:

God is the author of human sexuality and as such, offers the wisest, healthiest, and most satisfying guidelines for sexual activity.

Men and women are beings created by God in His image and designed to display His glory.

The only Biblically legitimate marriage union is the joining of one man and one woman in a binding covenant relationship.

But at the beginning of creation God made them male and female. For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will become one flesh. So they are no longer two, but one.

Mark 10:6-8 [NIV]

God has commanded, for our good, that there should be no sexual deviation from God's perfect design for sexual intimacy as outlined by Scripture.

Marriage should be honored by all and the marriage bed kept pure, for God will judge the adulterer and all the sexually immoral. Hebrews 13:4 [NIV]

You shall not commit adultery. Exodus 20:14 [NIV]

It is God's will that you should be sanctified: that you should avoid sexual immorality; that each of you should learn to control his own body in a way that is holy and honorable, not in passionate lust like the heathen who do not know God.

I Thessalonians 4:3-5 [NIV]

Or do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived: neither the sexually immoral, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor men who practice homosexuality.
